

FAQ

1. What is the difference between the 2 courses offered?

First Aid at Work, FAW, covers CPR and AED plus advanced first aid.

Emergency First Aid at Work, EFAW, covers CPR and AED plus basic first aid.

2. What is the duration of each course?

FAW is held over 3 days, from 08.30 to 17.00 each day

EFAW is held over 1 day, from 08.30 to 17.00

3. Where are the courses conducted?

Both courses are held on the KAUST CAMPUS and at the SAFAA STADIUM

4. Are the courses at the 2 venues the same?

Yes. Choose the date most suitable to you.

5. How do I choose a suitable course?

FAW is ideal for lab users, field trip participants and anyone who has already completed a basic first aid course. All participants must be proficient in the English Language.

EFAW is suitable for all with no previous qualification or experience in first aid. All participants must be proficient in the English Language.

6. Who pays for the course?

Each participant needs to obtain approval from their PI/Line Manager before registering for any course. You MUST bring your cost center number to the session for billing purposes.
