Labels Must:	70% Ethanol	
 Be in English 		
 Be Clear and Legible. 	Flammable RST	
Have full name of contents		
 If abbreviations are used, an <u>Abbreviation Key</u> must be posted 	Information obtained by labeling	
Contain the concentration of the chemical or solution		
 Contain the hazard information 	Chemical Name: ETHANOL	
	Concentration: 70%	
Even if the chemical or solution is non-hazardous (e.g. Water)	Hazard Information: FLAMMABLE	
it must still have a label on the container.	Date Created: December 10, 2019
