



## Labeling Secondary Containers

**Why?** Due to number of occurrences observed during inspections this year, the Research Safety Team would like to remind the campus of the labeling requirements for secondary containers.

### Labels Must:

- Be in English
- Be Clear and Legible.
- Have full name of contents
  - If abbreviations are used, an Abbreviation Key must be posted
- Contain the concentration of the chemical or solution
- Contain the hazard information

Even if the chemical or solution is non-hazardous (e.g. Water) it must still have a label on the container.
