E-Scooting in KAUST The Do's and Don'ts of operating an e-scooter in KAUST



Electric scooters (e-scooters) are light, battery-powered scooters that have two wheels, handlebars, brakes, with a floorboard that can be stood upon while riding.

Things to Consider When Buying an E-Scooter:

- The e-scooter is fitted with a breaking system;
- · Has a minimum of two wheels;
- After dark, you are required to have a white light to the front and a red light to the rear.



RULES OF THE ROAD AND ETIQUETTE



BE SAFE Travel with traffic and obey all traffic signals and signs.



BE ALERT Always be aware of surrounding traffic.



BE CONSIDERATE

Give way to pedestrians. Give a friendly warning before passing a pedestrian, cyclist or other road-user.



Do not carry passengers or tow, push or pull another object.

- · Do not park e-scooters at bus stops as it can block pedestrians or other transport.
- Do not park at emergency exits or doorways. The e-scooter can block the pathway and cause an incident.
- Please do not leave an e-scooter flat on the ground or park on footpaths which can cause accidents for pedestrians and other riders.
- Park your e-scooter out of the way of others, for example, by a bike rack.
